As of today, this trade mission will include more than two dozen special invitees including six African Ambassadors, African cabinet-level officials, and ten farmers and food company representatives representing five African countries. In addition, several food and farming officials from Washington D.C., and Minnesota, plus African Diaspora agriculturalists, will join us for the FarmFest tour.

You will have the opportunity to meet and connect with the Minnesota Congressional delegation, and local and state government leaders. More than 10,000 leaders from various business sectors including agriculture, banking and finance, education, energy, mining, medical/healthcare and technology will be at FarmFest to discuss and highlight the importance of these many businesses and their impact on global markets, with a special focus on Africa.













You will also have B2B connections with company executives facilitated by MAU and partners that will open up business opportunities between Minnesota and Africa. You will discover the latest in agricultural technologies, sustainable practices, and innovative solutions to enhance productivity and efficiency. We will facilitate introductions and interactions with key agricultural business leaders and congressional members to explore potential collaborations.


